


Egypt Tour

Our Itinerary

Day 1: Sunday July 8

Individual travel to Egypt begins.

Day 2: Monday July 9

Each traveller will be met at the Cairo Airport and assisted through the visa process (\$20 fee for visa not included) and transported to our luxury 5-star hotel in Giza. Egyptian dinner at a lovely local restaurant is included.

Day 3: Tuesday July 10


Early morning transfer to the airport for a flight to Aswan. Morning is free to shop at the wonderful outdoor street bazaar or add an excursion to Abu Simbel. Lunch onboard cruise ship. Sail a felucca! Three meals included.

Day 4: Wednesday July 11

Visit the Aswan High Dam and magnificent Temple of Philae. Sail to Kom Ombo dedicated to the gods. Three meals included.

Day 5: Thursday July 12

Visit the Temple of Horus at Edfu. Sail to Esna, cross the lock and on to Luxor for an overnight. Three meals included.



Day 6: Friday July 13

In Luxor, cross the Nile for an early morning visit to the Valley of the Kings and the Valley of the Queens. Half day free. Three meals included.

Day 7: Saturday July 14

Early morning visit to the Luxor and Karnak Temples. Disembark and transfer to a luxury hotel for a leisurely swim or more sightseeing. A fellucca captain is on call if you want to sail! Breakfast included.

Day 8: Sunday July 15

The Luxor Museum in the morning. A visit to the marketplace has multitudes of wares to meet every taste and desire. A hot air balloon excursion at dawn is available. Mid-afternoon transfer by motor coach to a luxury resort on the Red Sea in Hurghada. Breakfast & Dinner included.

Day 9: Monday July 16

Unwind at a luxury resort on the Red Sea. Spend a few days decompressing, swimming, relaxing, snorkeling and enjoying a completely different aspect of Egyptian hospitality. Breakfast & Dinner included.

Day 10: Tuesday July 17

More time to relax and reflect on the beach. If you dive, arrangements can be made for an awesome experience. The Red Sea is one of the premiere diving destinations in the world! Breakfast & Dinner included.



Day 11: Wednesday July 18

Early morning flight to Cairo. After lunch, off to Sakkara to visit the Step Pyramid of Zozer. Breakfast included.

Morning at the Giza Plateau. Plenty of time to explore and experience the power and majesty of the Great Pyramids. Camel Rides available for the adventurous. After a local lunch, head to the city to walk the oldest part of Cairo with its Coptic and Islamic historic sites including the Citidel of Saladin and the Church of St. Surgis.

Day 13: Friday July 20

Early morning trip to the Cairo Museum where our guide introduces us to the masterpieces, and of course the treasures of Tutankhamun. Afterwards a walking tour of the Khan El Khalili Bazaar. You won't want to leave! Breakfast & Lunch included.

Day 14: Saturday July 21

Full day excursion to Alexandria, visiting the Roman Catacombs and the new library. Breakfast included.

Day 15: Sunday July 22

Full day at leisure. Day transportation can be arranged!
